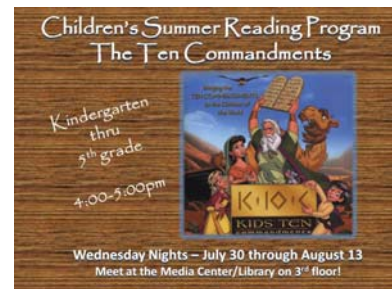
Book 3: *Echoes*
