#### **Covenant Child** by Terri Blackstock

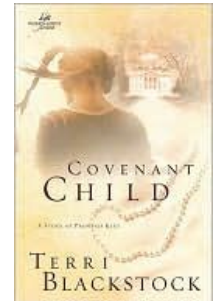
They grew up in squalor. Never guessing the riches held in trust for them or the love that lived to call them home.

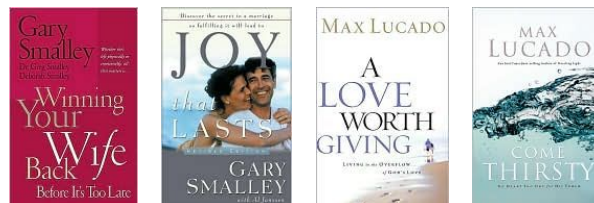
But then Amanda arrives with gifts and an amazing story--and even more unbelievable offer--and everything the twins have ever know goes out the window. She says that she's always loved them. But now she wants the twins to come live with her. She wants them to have their full inheritance.
