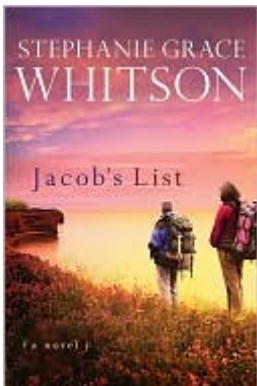


Media Center/Library: Recommended Additions *June 2008*
