MISSION JC: The Basics

- **Mission JC is a morning of service in our community. It began in 2013 with one church. Today it includes ten churches, over 700 volunteers, and over 60 projects.**
- **10 PARTNER CHURCHES in 2019:** Central United Church of Christ, Community Christian, Familia Cristiana Internacional, First Baptist, First United Methodist, First Presbyterian, Living Hope, Memorial Baptist, Oasis United Church of Christ, and Southridge Baptist.
- **PROJECTS:** Read about each of our projects online at www.missionjc.org.
- **REGISTRATION:** Register online at www.missionjc.org beginning April 1. Children under 12 years of age do not need to register separately or be included in a project registration count. Once you register, you'll receive an email confirmation. Details of each project are online.
- **CHILDCARE:** Childcare is provided for children birth-age 3. Contact First Baptist Church at 573.634.3603 to register your child. Preregistration by April 16 is required. On April 28, you may drop your child off at First Baptist Church beginning at 8 a.m. and pick them up when your project is completed. Go to "Door 6" on the Monroe Street side of the church and follow the signs. We encourage families to serve together so feel free to include your child with you on your project.
- **RAIN:** In the event of rain, our kickoff service will continue as planned. Some outdoor projects may be called off. We will post updates online regarding projects. You may come to the kickoff service and we will do our best to find you another project to join.
- If you opt not to participate in Mission JC and your church is canceling services, we encourage you to worship at one of the Mission JC partner churches gathering for worship that Sunday: Central United Church of Christ, Community Christian Church, First Methodist, or First Presbyterian. You may go to their websites for service times.
